WHAT IS KADAIKODI

One control plane for the whole selling surface

Most commerce teams stitch their stack together by hand: a cart here, a checkout SDK there, a separate product system, an order tool that doesn't talk to fulfilment, and analytics scattered across dashboards. Every seam is where carts get abandoned, inventory drifts, and orders fall through. Kadaikodi collapses that stack into a **headless cart-as-a-service backend** with storefront and back-office operations on top — so the cart, the catalog, the order, the merchant, and the people who fulfil it live in one consistent, governed model.

Headless cart & checkout

A durable, API-first cart and checkout engine you drive from any storefront, app, or kiosk over GraphQL — pricing computed on the server so every surface agrees.

Products & services, one model

Sell a bag of coffee and book a haircut through the same catalog, cart, checkout, and order lifecycle. Products carry stock; services carry duration.

Full order lifecycle

Placed → confirmed → preparing → ready → out for delivery → delivered → completed, with an independent payment state machine and an auditable timeline.

Merchant & fulfilment ops

Onboard and verify merchants, brand their storefront, roster workers, and dispatch delivery, pickup, on-location, and home-service tasks.

Shopper

- 1 Discover**
Browse merchants and offerings; filter by category, search by name.
- 2 Cart**
Add products and bookable services to one cart, with per-item options.
- 3 Checkout**
Pick fulfilment, address, and payment; see server-computed totals.
- 4 Track & review**
Follow the order through its lifecycle; leave a review on completion.

Merchant & fulfilment

- 1 Onboard**
Register, set category, offering type, hours, and branding.
- 2 List**
Products with stock, services with duration — prices, media, tags.
- 3 Sell**
Advance orders through the lifecycle from the back office.
- 4 Fulfil**
Assign workers, dispatch tasks, respond to reviews.

One model at any scale

D2C & B2C brands

A headless cart and checkout under your own storefront, no commerce plumbing to build.

B2B & wholesale

Catalogs and order workflows beyond a consumer cart, with account-based needs.

Marketplace operators

Merchant onboarding, verification, and per-merchant catalogs and analytics in one place.

Local commerce & services

Sell products and bookable services — food, retail, repair, home, personal care, health.

Operations & fulfilment

Manage workers, dispatch, delivery, pickup, and on-location jobs against live orders.

Commerce engineers

An API-first, GraphQL-native backend to compose into any front end.

WHY KADAIKODI

Built to replace the stack, not add to it

The cart is infrastructure

Durable, headless, and reusable across web, mobile, kiosk, and agents — it survives device switches and network drops.

Inherited enterprise backbone

Auth, RBAC, billing, files, tags, conversations, notifications, i18n, accessibility, and audit come from the Burdenoff platform — every release ships enterprise-ready.

Merchant financing, uniquely

The businesses powering a marketplace can raise transparent, governed growth capital from the people who believe in them.

Multi-tenant by default

Every merchant, offering, order, worker, and review is workspace-scoped — a single brand and a thousand-merchant marketplace run on the same isolation model.

EDITIONS & PRICING

Transparent, commerce-shaped tiers

A commission-friendly entry tier for new merchants, subscription tiers that lower commission as you scale, and enterprise terms for marketplaces and large catalogs. Regional pricing is published openly. Kadaikodi is pre-launch — plans go live at the 2026 launch.

Web app

Storefront, merchant back office, worker app, investor portal, admin console — role-aware.

Mobile app

Capacitor iOS & Android for shoppers, merchants on the move, and field workers.

Headless GraphQL API

The integration substrate — drive cart, catalog, orders, merchants, and fulfilment from any front end.

CLI & SDKs

Terminal automation plus Node and Python SDKs for storefronts, ops, and data workflows.

MCP server

Query catalog, build carts, and check orders from Claude and any MCP-compatible AI agent.

Browser & code extensions

Quick stats and in-editor access to the commerce API while you work.

Mobile, CLI, MCP, SDKs, and extensions are part of the launch surface plan and roll out progressively.

Common questions

Is Kadaikodi available today?

It's pre-launch, with a waitlist open ahead of a 2026 launch. Capabilities are labelled Available, In progress, or Planned so you always know what's real.

Products or services — which?

Both, in one model. The same cart, checkout, and order lifecycle handles physical products and bookable services.

Is it really headless?

Yes. The cart, catalog, and order API drive any storefront; the web app and back office are clients of that same API.

How is multi-tenancy handled?

Every entity is workspace-scoped. One workspace can be a single brand or an entire marketplace, with RBAC and audit built in.
